2014-2015 Governor's Interclub Contest

WHAT IS AN INTERCLUB AND WHO CAN WE VISIT?

When a specified number of members of a Kiwanis club visit another Kiwanis club or Service Leadership club at a regular meeting or any other organized Kiwanis Family function, it qualifies as an interclub. The number of members needed for an interclub is dependent upon the size of your club. You are encouraged to visit your sponsored Service Leadership clubs and observe their activities and participate in them, if possible. This includes Key Club, Circle K, Aktion Club, Builders Club, and K-Kids. District Governor Dan Yates hopes every club will interclub with every other Kiwanis club in their division during the contest which runs from Oct. 1, 2014 to Sept. 30, 2015.

RULES FOR AN INTERCLUB

The number of members required for attending an interclub are as follows (with club membership total as of Oct. 1, 2014):

- A club of 24 members or less two members are required. (Coral)
- A club of 25 through 50 members three members are required. (Emerald)
- A club of 51 through 75 members four members are required. (Ruby)
- A club of 76 members or more four members are required. (Diamond)

RULES FOR EARNING POINTS:

- An interclub to a club *in* your division 10 points
- An interclub to a club *outside* your division **15 points.**
- An interclub attending Mid-Winter Conference 25 points (no mileage pts)
- Mo-Ark District Convention (August)
 25 points (no mileage points)
- An interclub attending International Convention, Indianapolis, Indiana. (June 2015) **50 points** (*no mileage points!*)
- A bonus of *10 times* the number of clubs in your division is earned if ALL clubs in your division are interclubbed with during the contest period.
- Points for miles driven the most direct route) ONE WAY to make an interclub visit will be computed as follows:

1 to 74 miles - **5 points**75 to 100 miles - **10 points**101 to 125 miles - **15 points**126 miles and over - **20 points**

- An additional 100 bonus points will be given if your club interclubs with every club in a division *other that your own*.
 100 points
- An additional 100 bonus points will be given if *everyone* in your club attends at least one interclub. 100 points

AWARDS

A banner patch will be awarded to each club visiting ALL clubs in their division.

A banner patch or plaque will be awarded to the club with the most points in each size category, provided they have interclubbed with all clubs in their division.

Additional recognition this year:

There will be bonuses for attending four interclubs for the Distinguished Member Award.

There will be bonuses for attending ten interclubs for the Distinguished Club Award.

Size category rules are based on number of members in your club on October 1, 2014, as follows:

Coral: Less than 24 members Emerald: 25 through 50 members Ruby: 51 through 75 members Diamond: 76 members or more

EACH CLUB'S INTERCLUB CHAIR-

MAN is asked to keep an accurate record of the club's activity based on the above rules and *submit a report to your club secretary each time you have an interclub*. It should contain the following information:

- Club name and location;
- size category and division number;
- the date and number of your club members making each interclub;
- the name, location, and division number of each club with which you interclubbed;
- miles ONE WAY and number of points earned for each interclub.
- include the number of points earned for inter-clubbing with ALL clubs in your division and points earned for attending Mo-Ark Mid-Winter Conference, International Convention, and Mo-Ark District Convention.

Thanks to all of you for the GREAT work you are doing to represent Kiwanis. Please continue to send in your Inter-Club reports on you monthly reports, but please send *me* your report at the end of the year. The information I receive from International does not let me know if you had an inter-club with each club in your division or if every member of your club attended an inter-club this year, or if you attended any conventions.
